Hidden Gems That Can't Be Missed

- ◆ Johnstown Region
 - Rock Run Recreation Area
 - Offers more than 50 miles of trail.
 - Covering more than 6,000 acres, Rock Run provides an endless network of trails for ATV/dirtbiker riders.
 - Since opening in May 2007, Rock Run has hosted more than 8,000 riders from 20 states including Alaska and California.
- ◆ Laurel Highlands Region
 - Field of Dreams Motocross Park
 - Miles of trails: 1 1/3 mile
 - The facility also includes a pee wee track for beginning riders, concessions, cabin rentals and a campground.
