## **Hidden Gems That Can’t Be Missed**

- ◆ State College Region
  - Tour, Roar, Explore...and More! (144 miles)
    - This tour begins near State College winding through Pennsylvania State University continuing along rolling farmland and along picturesque waterways.
    - Featured stops include the Pennsylvania Military Museum and the Swigart Antique Automobile Museum featuring antique cars.
- ◆ Laurel Highlands Region
  - Peaks and Valleys Tour (90 Miles)
    - This tour includes a stop over at Mt. Davis – Pennsylvania’s highest point at 3,213 feet.
    - Riders can make a stop at the famous miner’s site, where nine miners were rescued in 2002, as well as pay tribute to the 9/11 heroes of Flight 93.
